As a journalist as well as a lecturer, she is qualified in art history. She has lectured at the Saint Etienne Higher School of Art and Design, and has also taught at the ENSCI as well as Les Ateliers and at the Cantonal School of Art in Lausanne (ECAL).

Parallel to this, she collaborated in various events: Caravelles 2 (four-yearly International design festival), "Design: mirror of the century" (at the Grand Palais in Paris), and the Saint Etienne biennial.

She has authored several books including "C'est Quoi le Design?" [*What is Design?*] published by Autrement. She is a member of the Association Internationale des critiques d'Art (AICA).
